CIRCULAR

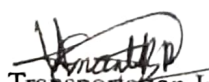
Students enrolled in the Academic Year 2026-27 who wish to utilize the college's transportation services are hereby notified to submit their request to the transport coordinator through the A-IMS system. This process requires adherence to the terms and conditions outlined in the college's transport policy, in addition to obtaining a parental consent letter.

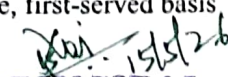
The college's transportation services will be available on all designated routes starting from 6th July 2026 for the odd semester. Students should be aware that during examination periods, the transportation routes will be limited in operation. The Route details, boarding point and stage information's are attached for your kind reference. The revised transportation fees for the academic year 2026-27 are as follows.

Sl. No	STAGE	Fees Structure in Rs.
1	STAGE - 1	27,500/-
2	STAGE - 2	30,500/-
3	STAGE - 3	31,500/-
4	STAGE - 4	33,500/-

NOTE:

- The transportation facility will only be available to students who have cleared all their previous year's fee dues.
- The operation duration will be divided into two sessions - the odd semester [4 months+ 1 month (exam)] and the Even semester (4 months + 1 month (exam)). The exam service dates will be communicated according to the university guidelines.
- Once a student submits a request for the transportation facility, the paid fee amount will not be refunded. Requests to discontinue transportation services during the operational year will not be accepted, and the fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- During the first month of the Odd and Even semester, tentative routes will be operated to analyse the student strength and feasibility. The final routes may involve adding or reducing a few drop points.
- Students must carry their ID card or a copy of the fee receipt to show to the personnel or staff during random inspections. Failure to provide a valid document will result in the withdrawal of transportation services.
- Any student found using the transportation facility without opting for it or paying the fee will face strict disciplinary measures, including a penalty of three times the transportation
- The option to opt for the transportation facility on the A-IMS platform will only be available until the seats are fully booked. The seats will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
